JACKPOT

QUALIFYING GAMES

- No Limit and Limit cash games with blinds of 2-5 or smaller
- All qualifying cash games of Texas Hold'em will have \$1.00 removed from the pot, and added to the Bad Beat Jack Pot.
- Tournament play is excluded.
- There must be a minimum of 4 players dealt in the hand to collect the \$1.00.
- There must be a flop, and a pot of \$30.00 or more to collect the \$1.00.

QUALIFYING PLAYERS

- In order to be eligible for any funds, players must be able to produce proper ID.
A social security card may be necessary for certain amounts.
- Players must be dealt a hand at the time of the Bad Beat being hit. If a table is in-between hands when the Bad Beat hits, all players dealt in on the previous hand will be eligible for the player's share.
- Players that are not at the table will be dealt in a maximum of one hand, and at the player's request only.

QUALIFYING HANDS

- The Bad Beat Jack Pot will apply to Texas Hold'Em cash games only.
- All hands must be dealt to river card, and all action completed.
- The minimum hand requirements are Aces Full of Jacks or better losing to Four of a Kind or better.
- All qualifying hands must use both hole cards to make their best five card hand. In all cases, either four of a kind or full houses, the hands must have a pocket pair in order to qualify. In the case of straight or royal flushes, both hole cards must be used to make the best five card hand possible.
- In the event the qualifying hand is a Full House, the players' hole cards must make up the Three of a Kind portion of the Full House.
- Example: KK, QQ, and JJ would not qualify if the board has three Aces in it.
- In the event there are multiple qualifying losing hands only the highest losing hand will receive the "Loser's Share".

DISQUALIFYING HAND/SITUATIONS

- In the event that management deems the cards in play to be fouled, all qualifying hands will be null and void.
- In the event that management deems the passing of any information during the hand as collusion (conversation about possible Jack Pot hand), all qualifying hands will be null and void.
- In the event there are less than four players dealt in the hand, no funds will be collected, and all qualifying hands will be null and void.
- In the event there is less than \$30 in the pot (before the rake is removed); all qualifying hands will be null and void.
- Poker Room Management's decisions are final.

PRIZE POOL DISTRIBUTION

- At the time of the Bad Beat being hit, the daily posted amount will be divided as follows.
- %50 of the Jack Pot will be awarded to the player with the highest qualifying losing hand (the loser's share).
- %25 of the Jack Pot will be awarded to the player with the qualifying winning hand (the winner's share).
- %25 of the Jack Pot will be divided amongst all qualifying players in the room playing qualifying games (the players' share).

ALLOCATION OF COLLECTED FUNDS

- The initial seed funded by the casino will be divided as follows
 - %60 to the Jack Pot
 - %30 to the 1st Reserve
 - %10 to the 2nd Reserve
- %7 off the top of each day's collected funds will be pooled for future Poker Room Promotions. (All promotions must be preapproved by the Gaming Commission).
- The remaining amount of each day's collected funds will be divided as follows.
 - %60 to the Jack Pot
 - %30 to the 1st Reserve
 - %10 to the 2nd Reserve
- In the event the Jack Pot reaches \$100,000, the funds will be divided as follows.
 - %10 to the Jack Pot
 - %60 to the 1st Reserve
 - %30 to the 2nd Reserve
- In the event the 1st Reserve reaches \$100,000, the funds will be divided as follows.
 - %10 to the Jack Pot
 - %10 to the 1st Reserve
 - %80 to the 2nd Reserve
- In the event the 2nd Reserve reaches \$100,000, the funds will be divided as follows.
 - %34 to the Jack Pot
 - %33 to the 1st Reserve
 - %33 to the 2nd Reserve.

INFORMATION OF FUNDS COLLECTED, AND POSTED.

- Soft count will provide total amounts of funds collected daily via e-mail to Audit, Poker Supervisors and Poker Manager no later than 10am.
- Poker Room Supervisory staff will apply the numbers to the appropriate distribution worksheet and post the numbers in the room on a designated monitor.

PAY OUT PROCEDURES

- Dealing staff will notify their Supervisor of potential qualifying Jack Pot Hand, and will cease all dealing until verification process is completed.
- Supervisor will note the time of the potential hand for surveillance.
- Supervisor will verify all potential qualifying hands.
- Supervisor will count down and inspect the deck in play.
- Supervisor will call surveillance with time of Jack Pot being hit.
- Surveillance will return call with verification of potential qualifying hands, and table and seat number of all qualifying players' share hands.
- Once verification is complete, the set up in play will be pulled and labeled with; time, date, name and RHR # (if applicable) of the player with the qualifying losing hand. Sup
- Once the setup has been replaced, play can continue.
- Supervisor will apply information to worksheet to figure out pay outs for all parties that qualify, and give poker room cage staff a copy.
- Supervisor will give all players qualifying for a Player's Share a "Player's Share Card", that must be redeemed at the Poker Cage within 5 hours of cage receiving distribution worksheet.
- Any funds not collected within the 5 hour time frame will be placed in the 1st reserve.
- Supervisor will escort the guests receiving the Winner's Share and the Loser's Share to the cage for payout.
